## ITEM 5. OTHER EVENTS

Enzon, Inc. ("Enzon" or the "Company") has granted Rhone-Poulenc Rorer Inc. ("RPR") a worldwide, non-exclusive license to use Enzon's Single-Chain Antigen-Binding ("SCA") protein technology for intracellular expression of SCA proteins and for targeted vectors in the field of cell and gene therapy. RPR Gencell, the cell and gene therapy division of RPR, is planning to apply this technology to its in vivo and ex vivo gene therapy programs in cancer, cardiovascular disease and immunology. RPR paid Enzon a \$1,000,000 license fee and will make additional payments upon the achievement of specified product development milestones. RPR will also pay Enzon a royalty based upon sales of products incorporating the Enzon technology.
